Sealed bids will be received by the District Forester, Portland, Oregon, up to and including July 31st, 1920, for all the merchantable dead timber standing or down, and all the live timber marked or designated for cutting on any one or all of three areas, namely, Unit I embracing about 105 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 13, T 14 S, R 33 E., W. M. estimated to contain 900,000 feet B. M. of western yellow pine and 40,000 feet B. M. of Douglas fir and other species; Unit II embracing about 10 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 19, T 14 S, R 34 E., W. M., estimated to contain 100,000 feet B. M. of western yellow pine and other species; and Unit III embracing about 100 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  and E $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. 13, and N $\frac{1}{2}$  Sec. 24, T 14 S, R 33 E., W. M. estimated to contain 1,000,000 feet B. M. of western yellow pine and 140,000 feet B. M. of Douglas fir and other species, all within the Malheur National Forest, Oregon. No bid of less than \$2.50 per M. feet for pine, \$1.00 per M. feet for Douglas fir and western larch and \$0.50 per M. for white fir will be considered. Deposit with bid \$300.
